

Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct:

The AIA stands for universal respect for human dignity, and the unbiased treatment of all persons in employment, civic, and business transactions regardless of race, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, physical abilities, or religious practices.

In addition, the Rules of Conduct of the AIA Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct are mandatory for all AIA members and enforceable by the National Ethics Council.

- Rule 1.401 – Members shall not engage in harassment or discrimination in their professional activities on the basis of race, religion, national origin, age, disability, caregiver status, gender, gender identity, or sexual orientation.
- Rule 1.402 – Members shall not engage in conduct involving wanton disregard of the rights of others.
- Rule 2.101 – Members shall not, in the conduct of their professional practice, knowingly violate the law.
- Rule 2.104 – Members shall not engage in conduct involving fraud.

- I/we affirm that I/we uphold this value in all business and professional practices, and in all activities and conduct relating to the AIA.

-I/We affirm that, throughout the course of my AIA membership, I/we have consistently abided by the standards set by Rules 1.401, 1.402, 2.101 and 2. 104 of the 2018 AIA Code of Ethics and have not engaged in conduct that may have violated the standards stated there. **(If you are not an AIA member, this still applies for the sake of this application.)**
